

When attending an eviction court hearing, it might be helpful to have the following documents or materials available:

- □ All papers related to the eviction case. Court papers, eviction notice, notices from the court
- □ The lease or rental agreement.
- □ Details about your rent.
 - ____ Receipts, canceled checks, proof of rent payment
 - Papers from any housing assistance programs Rent determination letters or certification from a housing authority, application for assistance, proof of rental assistance payments
- □ Written letters, copies emails/texts, or communication between you and your landlord.
- □ Any notices or letters from your landlord.
- □ Electric, gas, or other utility bills or notices, if there is a utility issue in your case.
- Printed pictures or written documentation of the problems/conditions in your home with the date pictures were taken or documentation made.
- Any other documents or papers that have something to do with your case that you would like to share with the court.
