- 4. After dating and signing the form, you will make three (3) copies of both the motion and order to continue for the Judge, for you, and for the other party.
- 5. You will bring the original and <u>all</u> copies of the motion and order to continue to the court for filing.
- 6. You will also bring (2) *self-addressed <u>stamped</u> envelopes.* One envelope will be addressed to you and the other envelope will be addressed to the other party involved in the case. *If there are any additional parties involved, please provide self-addressed stamped envelopes for those parties as well.*

The motion and order to continue will be sent to the Judge for review. The Judge will review the motion, if approved the Judge will sign the order granting the continuance and reschedule the hearing to a following date. Copies of the order to continue will be mailed to all parties in the envelopes provided by the party filing.
